# Instructions for Lights for Services When Dark or Going To Be Dark Outside

## For first service or early service ushers:

- Western Avenue exterior lights On/off switches are in light switch box next to door. Lift cover on box to access switch.
- Bell Tower exterior lights On/off switches are in light switch box next to door. Lift cover on box to access switch.
- Stanley Street and west parking lot exterior lights are in the elevator room going into the
  Honduras Room Above the breaker box is a smaller box, open door to it and turn lever to ON.
   (Note: At one time this lever was part of a timer switch.)
- Christian Education entry –Turn on 2 switches in the entry, plus in the vestibule/lobby (where bathrooms are located), turn on top switch to the right of the doorway in the lobby. Turn on all other lights going downstairs and going up to offices.
- Altar stained glass windows (above altar) Switches are next to safe in the sacristy. Turn on both switches to the left of the safe, one for the room and one for the windows "back light".
- Other lights Turn on in fellowship hall, offices, and church.

## Second service or last service ushers- use above instructions in reverse.

## Instructions for Heat and A/C

<u>Sanctuary thermostat</u> is pre-programmed for heat (in winter to 62 degrees) and scheduled to come on prior to Sunday services to warm church; no adjustment needed. For services other than Sunday services, the temperature must be manually increased by using the **UP** arrow to 70 degrees. Can be turned down after mid-afternoon/early evening services, using the **DOWN** arrow to 62 degrees. However, the thermostat will reprogram itself to pre-programmed settings.

<u>Honduras Room</u> thermostat is a manual 3-way switch with settings for Heat-Off-A/C.

### In WINTER it should be set to heat.

First service ushers – Using **UP** arrow raise the temperature setting to 70 degrees, more if needed. Second or last service ushers – Using **DOWN** arrow lower temperature to 62 degrees.

### In **SUMMER**, thermostat should be set to **A/C**.

First service ushers – Using **DOWN** arrow lower the temperature setting to about 74 degrees, lower if needed.

Second or last service ushers – Turn A/C **OFF**.

Note: Care needs to be taken to ensure **A/C** button is not turned on in winter as it will destroy compressor.
